In a recent U-turn by NHS Improvement, plans to restrict substantive NHS staff from working shifts for another trust via an agency have been paused.

NHSI released an update that said: “Following feedback from nurses about our latest agency rules on substantive staff, we’ve clarified our rules. Until further notice, we’re pausing our instruction that providers should ensure staff employed through an agency are not substantively employed elsewhere in the NHS.”

They went on to confirm: “This new rule will not start from 1 April 2017 and providers’ normal processes can remain in place.”

IR35 rules will; however, continue as intended.
